### LLOYD INSTITUTE OF MEDIATION & ARBITRATION (LIMA) ::

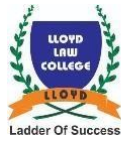

For the same, LIMA does hereby invite papers, articles, case reviews, case summaries, and research papers along with any other form of write-ups concerned with the theme of ADR.

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES ::

1. Co-authorship is allowed for up to two authors only.
2. The article should be submitted along with the title page. The title page should have the following details: article title, author's name, contact particulars, and email ID for future correspondence.
3. The summary/short extract should not exceed 200 words (which would not be counted in the word limit for the main article).
4. The article should be submitted in a Word document and Pdf Format via the submission form only.
5. The article and extract should be written in 12 pt Times New Roman font with a 1-inch margin on all sides, 1.5 paragraph spacing, and a footer numbering pages as "page x of y".
6. Endnotes should be used rather than footnotes. Authors should not use supra, infra, or ibid and should give full reference of the citation/ authority/ reference, etc. wherever applicable.



7. Avoid extensive endnotes or extensive quotations. Reference or paraphrasing of thoughts and ideas from standard works are acceptable without quotations, provided they are duly acknowledged in footnotes or otherwise as may be suitable.
8. Any form of written submission should be a minimum of 1000 words.
9. Every submission should have endnotes.
10. The word limit for case review shall be 1000-1200 words.
11. The word limit for the article shall be 1200-1500 words.
12. The word limit for the research paper shall be 3000 – 5000 words.

**NOTE ::** The selection of the paper will be at the discretion of the selection board, mere submission does not guarantee publication.

**DEADLINE::** Submissions to be made by 25th April 2024, 11:59 p.m.
