**NOTE ::** The following forms part of the marking criteria.

**Introduction ::** Start with a brief introduction of yourself and your research topic. Clearly state the purpose of your research and its significance and importance. Clarity of Subject Matter, Statement of Problem Research Question/Objective, Hypothesis.

**Objective of Study ::** Explain why this question or objective is important and how it contributes to the legal field and law and society.

**Literature Review ::** Summarize relevant research that has been done in this area. Highlight any gaps or limitations in the existing literature that your research addresses.



**Legal Research Methodology ::** Explain your research approach and methodology. Describe the methods you used to collect and analyse data. Justify why your chosen methodology is appropriate for answering your research question.

**Results ::** Present your findings clearly and concisely. Use visuals such as graphs or charts to illustrate your results if applicable. Interpret the results and explain their implications.

**Discussion ::** Discuss the significance of your findings in relation to your research question. Address any unexpected results or limitations of your study. Compare your results with previous research and explain how they contribute to the existing knowledge in the field.

**Conclusion ::** Discuss the conclusion and findings of your study. Summarize the main points of your presentation. Reiterate the importance of your research and its potential impact on society. Discuss any future research directions or implications of your findings.
