## **Lloyd Judgment Writing Competition 1.0 :: Live Case** **Open for All the Law Students from Delhi-NCR Region**

Dear Parent / Student

Greetings from Lloyd Academic Community!

We are glad to introduce our new invention in academic domain, i.e., a judgment writing competition on live cases. This is in continuation of our efforts to give our students all possible opportunities to learn law through stimulating exercises. We have been conducting various intra-college training-cum-competitions, like LTAC, LCAC, LWPAC, LCPC, LCDRC, & ors. for past many years, this is one more effort at our end to equip the law students with skills that are better than any other competitor whenever he/she will join the professional world.

Legal profession is not only about oral communication skills, now-a-days writing skills are as important in legal profession as oral communication skills are. One of such written mode of communication in the legal profession is JUDGMENT through which a judge justifies the justice that he/she has delivered in given case; and, the same judgment becomes the most important source of literature for everyone for the purpose of understanding what the law is. Students of today will either be writing or reading the judgements tomorrow, hence they should have skills of writing / reading judgments. If they are taught how to write judgments through innovative mechanism, they will understand the judgments in better way.

Considering the importance of writing / reading judgments for every legal professional, and considering the transcripts of arguments (*presented in cases before the Supreme Court of India*) being made available at website of the Supreme Court, we have come up with this unique & first of its kind of competition, i.e., Judgment Writing Competition on live cases. We are glad to introduce the Intra-college Judgment Writing Competition in line of the following process:

### **1. Subject Matter of Judgment ::**

- Judgment to be written by the participants will be on a real-life case in which final arguments before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India have already been completed, and judgment is kept reserved;
- This will be shared on the date of workshop in which participation is compulsory for the participating students;

### **2. Judgment Writing ::**

- Participating students will have to write judgment on given case by using the 'transcript of arguments of both the parties' that is made available on website of the Supreme Court of India;
- Further, participants can use their own material for writing judgment;
- Judgment writing will be done in campus of Lloyd Law College;

### **3. Training through Workshop ::**

- A workshop will be conducted to give training on judgment writing;



- This workshop will be conducted by experts, including judge, advocate, & teacher;
  - It will be conducted in the campus of Lloyd as per following schedule;
4. **Submitted judgments will be assessed** on the basis of judgment that will be delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in due course of time;

**5. Instructions for the participants ::**

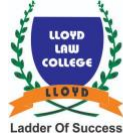
- Registration as per details given herein below;

- Desktop, without internet facility, will be provided to the participants for the purpose of writing the judgment;
- Participants can bring & use any material, in hard-copy, on the date of judgment writing;
- Electronic device can't be used;
- Two questions on given case will be shared with the participants on the date of competition, and participants will write judgment while answering those questions;
- Besides these questions, participants may frame their own question/s and write answer to those question/s;
