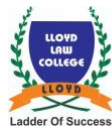

Legal education is principally a justice education. Legal profession in its entirety is a service imparted through judging, advising or counseling in law courts. India being an adversarial legal system, this requires acquiring legal and allied knowledge and learning professional & personality skill set. Alongside academic progression, development of personality and professional skill set is the one most important imperative of legal education that a novice should understand when to be 'thinking like lawyer' and when 'thinking not like a lawyer'. All the legal and non-legal simulation exercises are formed to cultivate professional personality in the novices.

#### Lloyd Criminal Trial Advocacy Competition 5.0 ::

Lloyd had introduced a unique learning activity, i.e., Lloyd Criminal Trial Advocacy Competition (L-TAC) for its students in 2018; we have successfully completed four editions of the L-TAC. It gives opportunities to students of the Lloyd Law College / Lloyd School of Law to participate and learn practical aspects of the criminal trial through role plays and simulation exercises, and to find themselves ready for the profession after completing L-TAC.

LTAC is an annual event; one cycle of the competition will take 06 -to- 08 months to complete in which participating student will be playing various roles, like, Victim / Complainant, Duty Officer @ Police Station, Investigation Officer, Public Prosecutor, Defense Counsel etc. It will be conducted in multiple stages completing one cycle of any criminal matter starting from reporting matter to the police to delivery of verdict by the trial court.

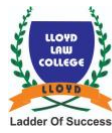

**GUIDELINES RELATED TO SCREENING TEST ::**

1. There shall be two screening tests. One is **Written Test [40 Marks]** and the other is **Personal Interview [10 Marks]**.
2. The written test shall be **problem based Open Book Test**.
3. All the batches will be given same question paper; however, the set may vary.
4. Applicants can use bare acts of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, Indian Evidence Act, 1872, Indian Penal Code 1860, or/and any other study material during the test.
