Ms. Vasundhra Minocha has graduated from BBA, LL.B course at Symbiosis Law School, Pune ("SLS") where she was awarded as 'Best Outgoing Student'. During her studies at SLS, she interned with leading law firms inter alia Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas, Jyoti Sagar Associates as well as leading lawyers such as Mr. Rajeev Dhavan. To explore the various other facets of the legal field she also interned at PRS Legislative Research and Nani Palkiwala Arbitration Centre. Further, she also volunteered with non-profit organizations such as Transparency International India and Commonwealth Human Rights Initiative.

Ms. Minocha pursued LL.M from Cornell Law School, Ithaca, New York and was awarded the 'CALI Excellence for Future Award' for achieving the highest grade in the 'Dispute Resolution Practicum' course. In 2017, Miss Minocha joined the Projects and project finance practice at Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas, New Delhi, India. As part of the Project and project finance practice, her work entailed assisting and advising domestic as well as foreign clients engaged in various sectors through the life cycle of financing and public private partnership transactions including structuring, negotiations, due diligence, preparing transaction documentation and 'requests for proposal', undertaking pre and post-closing deal related documentation, filings and intimations.

Ms. Minocha has worked as in Khaitan & Co. from mid-2018- May 2021. She was promoted to Senior Associate in April 2021. She is currently running an independent legal practice. As part of the general corporate practice, her work entails assisting and advising domestic and foreign clients engaged in various sectors through the life cycle of a deal including (a) structuring, (b) negotiating, (c) due diligence exercise, (d) preparation and finalization of transaction documents, and (e) undertaking pre and post-closing deal related documentation, filings and intimations.
