NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE MINORITIES

Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India

All the eligible students of Lloyd Law College are hereby informed that the applications for National Scholarship for the Minorities are invited (**Fresh Applications and Renewal Applications**) by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India, for the **academic session 2023-24**

Schemes: The schemes under this scholarship are as follows;

1. SCHEME OF 'POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Eligibility for Scheme 1 (all the following 3 conditions should be fulfilled):

1. The applicant must be a Minority i.e., Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, Jain or Zoroastrian (Parsi),
2. The applicant must have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous year examination (annual aggregate),
3. The annual income of parents/guardians of the applicant from all sources must not exceed **Rs.2.00 lakhs.**

2. SCHEME OF 'MERIT CUM MEANS BASED SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Eligibility for Scheme 2 (all the following 3 conditions should be fulfilled):

1. The applicant must be a Minority i.e., Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, Jain or Zoroastrian (Parsi),
2. The applicant must have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous year examination (annual aggregate),
3. The annual income of parents/guardians of the applicant from all sources must not exceed **Rs.2.50 lakhs.**

Procedure to apply: Visit the website <https://scholarships.gov.in/>

Fresh applicants have to get registered and the applicants applying for renewal have to login to their existing account. Fill the application form and upload the compulsory documents. After completing the application form, a bonafide certificate will be available for downloading. You have to take the print of the bonafide certificate and get it signed by your college before uploading it.

The following documents (hard copy) have to be submitted in the college during working days;

1. Print out of the duly filled in Application Form,
2. Print out of the Bonafide Certificate, as downloaded from your National Scholarship Portal Account,
3. Passport size Photograph,
4. Self-attested Copy of 10th Marksheet
5. Self-attested Copy of 12th Marksheet
6. Self-attested Copy of Graduation Marksheet (only for LL.B. 3-year Program students)
7. Self-attested Copies of Previous Year Mark sheets (both semesters of previous academic year)
8. Self-attested Copy of Aadhaar Card
9. Self-attested Copy of Income Certificate
10. Self-Declaration of Minority Community (**attached herewith for downloading**)
11. Self-attested Copy of Domicile Certificate
12. Self-attested Copy of Bank Passbook 1st Page, clearly indicating account number, IFSC and name of the account holder.
13. Fee Receipt of Current Course Year

The above mentioned documents have to be submitted to Ms. Tanu Sharma, Coordinator, Scholarship Committee in the Exam Cell, 1st Floor, Campus 1.

Important: The College shall verify and forward the forms of only such applicants who submit the hard copy of the documents. The verification of the forms shall be done only in the physical presence of the students.

Note: It is mandatory that the mobile number, Aadhaar card and bank account number of the applicant are synchronized.
