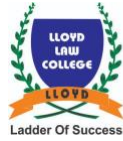

Thank you for registering in the Lloyd Civil Practice Competition 2.0. After successful registration all the applicants shall be going through two stages of **screening tests consists of Written Test and Personal Interview as per the Rule 08 of L-CPC Rulebook. The Written Test will be held on Saturday 10 Dec. 2022, IST 01 p.m., Lecture Hall - 02, Lloyd School of Law.**

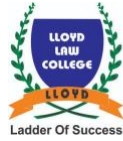
Kindly note the detailed guidelines of Lloyd Civil Practice Competition 2.0 procedure for Screening Rounds;

1. The written test shall consists of 35 marks containing both Subjective and Objective questions.
2. The written test shall be held through an Open Bare Act Method.
3. An applicant shall not be allowed more than one attempt.
4. All the applicants of all the batches shall be given same question paper; however, the set may vary.
5. **The participants need to present at the given venue before one hour i.e. at 12:00 p.m., there shall be no delay.**
6. The applicants will be provided with the sheets for their tests by the OC.
7. All the electronics items like Phones, smart watches will be submitted to the Organizing Committee members before the test start. After the completion of tests, students shall be given back their respective items that they have submitted to the OC.
8. The time duration of written test is of **ONE HOUR**. Therefore, no applicants shall be allowed to leave the exam room before the tests is completed.

1. Applicants shall be allowed to use bare acts of aforementioned subjects.
2. Applicants present at Written Test will be provided deemed attendance for the classes they miss for their test duration.
3. Students appearing for the written test are also required to be appear for the Interview, or else they would be disqualified.



4. Out of the total registrations received, only 30 students shall be selected on the combined score of both the written test and personal interview.
