Greetings from Lloyd Academic Community

As we know that undergraduate law degree program has seen major changes in last one decade. It has no longer remained a traditional degree program. Over period of time it has crossed the boundaries of the class-room teaching-learning tradition and has brought the real-life simulations within the curriculum of the program. This blend of class-room teaching-



learning and beyond class-room simulations has made the program unique in its own. Now a days, every law graduate as well as the legal profession expects that the student is profession-ready when he/she completes the program. Considering this all, Lloyd Law College, and Lloyd School of Law keep bringing opportunities, like, **LIMA, LTAC, LCPC**, etc., for their students to learn & understand the law as it is practiced in the profession. In continuation of our tradition to make our law schools as a more skill-enhancement platforms, we have come up with **Lloyd Criminal Appeal Competition (LCAC)** for our students.

I. Introduction

We have been conducting **Lloyd (Criminal) Trial Advocacy Competition (LTAC)** for last five years. It is a platform that gives opportunities to our students to learn & understand criminal trial and enhance their trial lawyering skills. Similarly, **LCAC** is a platform that gives opportunities to students to learn & understand criminal appeal law and enhance their appellate lawyering skills that includes drafting skills as well.

The **LCAC** shall be an annual event; one cycle of the competition will take 03 months to complete in which participating student will be playing roles of State Counsel as well as Counsel for a convict. It will be conducted at two stages, (i) Appeal before High Court, & (ii) Appeal before Supreme Court. Real life trial court files of cases decided by Courts of Session will be given to the participant. The participants will draft appeal to be filed before the High Court, and then they will plead it before the High Court. The same cases will be taken before the Supreme Court, either as statutory appeal or as constitutional appeal, by the participants. They will draft the appeal as per demand of the case, and then they will plead it before the Supreme Court.

II. Aim & Objective

The LCAC will provide a platform to the participants to learn and hone their drafting as well as argumentation skills. Primarily it aims at following:

- i. Participants will learn practical aspects of criminal appeal process;
- ii. Participants will learn and hone their advocacy skills, including drafting & pleading skills;
- iii. Participants will be profession-ready once they complete one cycle of the LCAC.

III. Process of Application & Schedule

- i. Applicant must be a student of either of the following batches:
BA.LLB (2018-23 / 2019-24 / 2020-25), LLB (2020-23 / 2021-24)



- ii. Selection process includes, (i) Application via email, (ii) Written Test (Objective & Descriptive), and (iii) Personal Interaction.
- iii. Application via email is qualifying in nature; Written Test will be of 20 Marks, and Personal Interaction will be of 20 Marks.
- iv. Final Merit List will be made of 40 Marks.
- v. Only 08 students will be selected for Stage I of the competition.
Four out of 08 participating students will qualify for Stage II of the competition.
- vi. Further details on Written Test & Personal Interaction will be shared with the applicants only.
