ANNEXURE -2

With the object of extending the benefit of scholarship to more number of students, the Scholarship Committee has introduced the following additional categories of scholarships*;

1. Physical Class Attendance Scholarship;

- i) 91% and above physical class attendance in the previous academic year: an amount of INR 5 000 /- to a maximum of 20 students of every Batch.
- ii) 86% to 90% physical class attendance in the previous academic year: an amount of INR 3000/- to a maximum of 20 students of every Batch.

2. University Examination Performance Based Scholarship;**

- i) 60% or above marks in previous academic year: an amount of INR 3000/- to a maximum of 20 students of every Batch.

3. Class Toppers Scholarship;**

Top 5 students of every Batch shall be given a scholarship as per the following scale;

- i) First Position: 25%
- ii) Second Position: 20%
- iii) Third Position: 15%
- iv) Fourth Position: 10%
- v) Fifth Position: 10%

* Provided that the student is not drawing any other category of scholarship under Lloyd Scholarship Policy.

** It is based on the performance in the previous academic year, counted annually i.e. taking both the semesters into consideration.

CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO EVERY SCHOLARSHIP

All kinds of Scholarship under Lloyd Scholarship Policy are subject to the fulfilment of following conditions;

- i) Minimum 75% physical class attendance (it shall mean the physical presence of the student in regular classes and shall not include deemed attendance and attendance earned through remedial classes)
- ii) Minimum 55% marks in previous academic year with no back paper
- iii) Submission of semester fee in time, as notified.
- iv) No disciplinary matter decided against the student, either by the CDC or Hostel Committee or Transport Committee.
- v) Submission of Scholarship Application Form in time.

***SCHOLARSHIP CONTINUATION POLICY 2022-23**

(for the subsequent years)

NOTE : SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED UNDER VARIOUS CATEGORIES ARE A PRIVILEGE, NOT THE RIGHT OF THE STUDENT.

Continuation of Scholarship:

Candidates are offered scholarship at the time of admission only for ONE ACADEMIC YEAR i.e. for first year only. Thereafter, continuation of the scholarship is subject to the following Qualifications & Conditions, strictly on the basis of **application submitted by the candidate** to the scholarship committee on time and as per the policy.

Qualifications & Conditions:

Every student is required to fulfill the following qualifications and conditions laid down by the

1. Scholarship aspirant must have submitted the duly filled in scholarship application form on or before due date as per the official notification by the Scholarship Committee.
2. Applicant must have attained 80% physical class attendance in both the semesters separately.
3. Applicant must have obtained minimum 55% score in CCS University, Meerut examinations annually, with no back / absent in any paper.
4. Applicant must not have any disciplinary action taken or pending before any authority viz. in the College / Police / Court.
5. Applicant must have deposited Semester Fee in time as per the official fee payment notification. Any delay in the fee payment shall debar the applicant from getting scholarship offered by the college.
6. The odd semester fee has to be deposited in full i.e. the batch fee and not the discounted fee. If the scholarship is continued, the fee shall be adjusted in **even semester fee payment**.
7. At any given time, no student can avail more than one scholarship including any government / private scholarship awarded by any institution / organization. Any violation of this rule scholarship awarded by the college shall be discontinued with immediate effect.
8. Those students who are depositing fees after the notified designated LAST DATE in the 03rd & 04th Quarter of academic session 2021-22 and 01st & 02nd Quarter of academic session 2022-23, for that purpose shall not be entitled to apply for the scholarship in the next academic session 2022-23.

Important Note:

- Scholarship can be claimed only through the scholarship form duly filled within the stipulated time as per the official notification from the scholarship committee.
- Scholarship is granted on annual fees, however it can be availed in the even semesters only after complete verification of the scholarship form and relevant papers submitted by the candidate.
- In any case if the scholarship is reduced due to non/partial fulfillment of the scholarship conditions, the reduced scholarship shall be considered in the next year at the sole discretion of scholarship committee.
- Scholarships once discontinued shall not be allowed in the future. However, any fresh scholarship may be granted if available to apply as per the discretion of scholarship committee.
- The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to change/alter/add/strike off any requirement or process of claiming the continuation of scholarship at any point of time. Any such change shall be notified to the students and the changes so made shall be final and binding on all the applicants.
