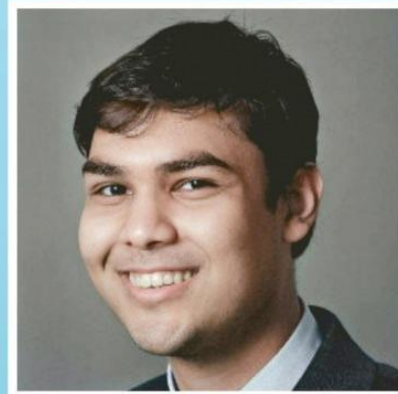

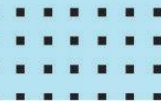

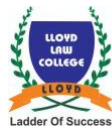

Mr. Soham is a Principal Associate with the 'competition and antitrust law' team of Khaitan & Co. Prior to working with Khaitan, Soham was associated with the 'competition law' team of Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas in its Mumbai office, and the 'competition and European law' team of De Brauw Blackstone Westbroek in its Brussels and Amsterdam office. As part of his practice, Soham regularly advises domestic and foreign clients in a wide breadth of competition law matters relating to anti-competitive agreements, abuse of dominant position and national and cross-border combinations. Soham also represents clients before the Competition Commission of India and the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal. Some of the recent marquee combinations advised by Soham include Parkway Pantai's acquisition of Fortis hospitals, formation of joint venture between British Petroleum and Reliance Industries Limited, merger of Bank of Baroda mutual fund with BNP Paribas mutual fund, formation of global joint venture between Honda Motors and Hitachi Limited, etc. Soham has also been involved with complex litigation matters representing clients like Adani Gas, Cube Cinema, Mahindra & Mahindra, etc. Soham also regularly advises various leading corporate houses on competition law related advisories and queries.

On the academic front, Soham is an alumni of NLU Patiala (Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law) where he specialised in business laws. After his LL.B., Soham completed his master's degree from Leiden University, the Netherlands with specialisation in European Union laws and European Competition Laws.

Alongside his practice, Soham contributes to a variety of publication houses on different issues involving competition laws in India and abroad. Soham's writings have been published in the Global Competition Review, Mondaq, Money Control, European Competition Law Review, etc. Soham has also published a number of articles on company and securities law in publications like, the International Energy Law Review, International Business Law Review, Business Law Review, etc. As part of an academic outreach effort, Soham leveraged on his strong meeting experience to remain keenly involved with moot exercises. He drafted the moot proposition for the Tenth NLU Antitrust Law Moot Court Competition, 2019 and the 9th IJNU National Moot Court Competition. Separately, Soham judges many antitrust and competition related moot court competitions across the country.
