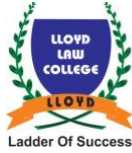

### **Role of the Volunteer:**

- As stenographer / court-master, volunteer will have to note down the proceedings, and complete them in the format required. (As will be provided)
- Volunteer will have to set up the court before the proceedings.
- Volunteer will have to assist the assigned Judges during the proceedings.

### **Benefits of being a Volunteer:**

- Learning the trial procedure through observing simulation exercises;
- Learning the court-room mannerism through participating in court proceedings as court-staff;
- Certificate of Appreciation will be awarded;
- Cash-prize of Rs. 2100/- (two thousand one hundred only) each to five best volunteers
