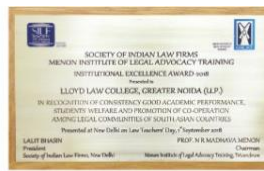

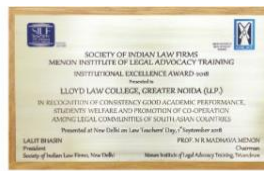

- Your video **must** be turned on with a **profile view**.
- **Dress formally & smartly.**

- The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

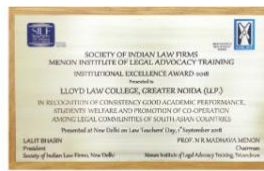
