Title :- “Post Brexit HR landscape in the UK and Humanitarian effort in Bangladesh for Rohingya population”

As a part of the extension lecture series at Lloyd, Mr. Prashanta B Barua was invited to discuss the post Brexit HR landscape in the UK and Humanitarian effort in Bangladesh for Rohingya population.

Mr. Prashanta B Barua is LL.M (University of Dhaka), LL.M (Queen Mary, University of London), Director of Studies & Head of Laws European College of Law Essex, United Kingdom.

The first part of the session was aimed to provide a deep understanding of the term Brexit, the reasons for Britain leaving the European Union and the implications of Brexit for global organizations and their HR teams that could potentially affect recruiting, hiring and employer branding for those organizations.

Dr. Salim organized the lecture in which students of Ist semester of BA LL.B participated. The lecture evoked an overwhelming response and also invited a lot of questions from the students.

The second part of the session focused on The Rohingya crisis that has reached unprecedented proportions in recent months with hundreds of thousands of people in need of humanitarian assistance. The session also gave an insight on the working of charitable organizations that are offering assistance to Rohingya, an ethnic group that has faced endemic persecution and violence in Burma.



The students attended the session with rapt attention. Many questions were posed on the position of Indian Government with regard to the Rohingya situation and the efforts being put in to normalize it. The session was very meaningful and informative for students.
