When two or more parties become embroiled in a legal dispute seeking money or another specific performance rather than criminal sanctions, civil litigation is the result. They must instead head to the courtroom for trial so a judge can decide the matter. Civil litigation encompasses a broad range of disputes, and litigators generally specialize in one or two specific practice areas. The various sectors of civil litigation include environmental law, landlord/tenant disputes, and intellectual property disputes among others. Civil litigation can be divided into several stages, including investigation, pleadings, discovery, pre-trial proceedings, potential settlement or trial, and even appeal.

Lloyd Law College prepared extension lecture series so that the students get to know about the challenges faced by the civil litigator including the pros and cons of the same.
