He is a regular contributor to various Hindi and English newspapers that include Dainik Jagran, Amar Ujjala and the Hindustan Times. He recently published chapters in the book edited by Paul Wallace titled India’s 2014 Elections. He has also contributed research papers to peer-reviewed, referred academic and research journals like Gandhi Marg and Social Action. He has also presented papers at national and international seminars in India and abroad.
